Itinerary & Directions

That Evening

4:00P - 6:00P **Set-up time**

Once you enter at the Gilroy Gardens sign, take another immediate left and do not go towards the Theme Park. Proceed through the Security Gate, and go approximately 200 yards. On your right-hand side enter a dirt lot "Parking Lot C" (Gate 8). Parking is Free to overnight campers.

5:30 - 7:00P **Dinner is served**

4:30P, 5:00P, 5:30P, 6:00P, 6:30P, 7:00P, 7:30P - Irrigation Talk and Reservoir Hike

Troops will be assigned a hike time upon arrival, this activity is approximately 1 hour: 20 minutes walk to the Reservoir, 20 minutes presentation and 20 minutes walk back to camp. The hike is moderate and slightly uphill. Some troops will hike, then have Dinner, while others will have Dinner and then hike. Long pants and sneakers are recommended.

10:30P - 7:30A **Lights Out/Quiet Hours**

Next Morning

7:30A **Breakfast is served**

8:30A **Family & Friends Check in at Front Gate**

9:00A-10:00A **WOW Program/ Waterfall demonstration**

Troops will rotate through 3 stations: Bonfante Falls, Coyote Lake and Lakeside Amphitheatre. Schedule will be assigned the evening before for troops in the campground and the day of for troops joining via the Front Gate in the morning.

10:00A Rides & Attractions open. Front Gate opens to public

10:00A - 12:00P Scout activities presented in the Event Tent.

12:00P Lunch served in camping area

3:00P Attendees must be cleared out of camping area

Directions

Take the 101 towards Gilroy
Exit on Leavesley Rd./CA 152-W/ CR-G9 W toward Gilroy/Watsonville
Turn left at Monterey St/CA-152
Turn right onto First St. /CA-152
Continue to follow CA-152
Enter at the Gilroy Gardens sign and follow directional signs to Camp Nights

Meals Served at Public Camp Nights:

All meals include unlimited Coca-Cola soft drinks and water

Day 1

Dinner 5:30pm-7:00pm

Spaghetti w/ marinara sauce, BBQ chicken, fruit salad, freshly baked rolls and ice cream novelties.

Day 2

Breakfast 7:30am-8:30am

Scrambled eggs, bacon, home-style potatoes, juice and coffee.

Lunch 12:00pm-1:00pm

Turkey and ham sandwiches, peanut butter & jelly sandwiches, all-beef hot dogs, and ice cream novelties.

(Wristbands are required to enter the camping and meal areas)

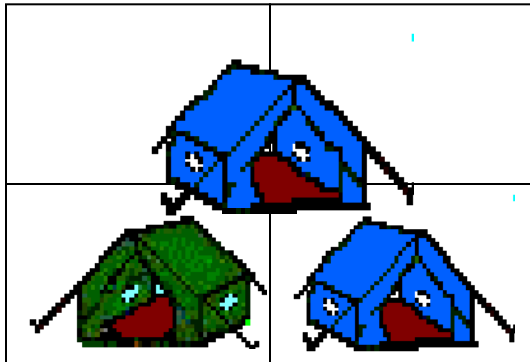
Tent Specifications

Due to the growing number of campers at Scout Camp Nights:

- Each troop may be assigned a number of 12' x 12' tent spaces on the field based on the number of people in your group [Example: every 4 people in a group would receive (1) 12' x 12' spaces on the field].
- Each tent space can hold up to 4 people comfortably.
- In support of council rules, members of the opposite sex have a designated sleeping area. Location is noted on the Camp Site Map.
- Please have entrance into tent facing the walkway
- Please respect the grounds and pick up trash
- Be Aware of water lines, while pounding in stakes for your tents, if you feel resistance, please remove the stake and move it over to another location.

Example:

A group of 16 would be assigned 4 spaces for their tents.



Prohibited Items List

For your safety and the safety of others we ask that the following items be left at home and not brought to Camp Nights:

Weapons/Firearms -

1. Pistols/Rifles/shotguns
2. BB guns
3. Paint guns/rifles
4. Knives of any kind and size
5. Pepper spray/mace

Outdoor equipment -

1. Shovels or any digging equipment
2. Saws
3. Axes/picks/hoes

Cooking equipment -

1. Gas/charcoal/wood stoves
2. Steno stoves
3. No open flame

Game/play equipment -

1. Lawn darts
2. Horse shoes
3. Roller skate/inline skates
4. Skate boards
5. Bicycles
6. Motorized vehicles

No pets of any kind except for “working” dogs.

No alcohol or controlled substance.

No campfires or other type of burning equipment.
